This is an innovative, cutting-edge course that will prepare you for a career in the design industry. You will develop design skills, technical and professional expertise through challenging project briefs, often in collaboration with industry and sponsorship by fabric manufacturers. Visits to trade fairs and manufacturers will provide an insight into international aspects of the business.

What will I study?

Year one (Level 4)

Core modules include Visualisation, Historical and Contextual Studies, Design Processes, Business and Professional Studies and Studio Practice.

Year two (Level 5)

Core modules include Industrial Practice, Fashion and Textiles Design, Fashion and Textiles Processes and Technology.

Year three (Level 6)

Compilation of a professional portfolio and a practical exhibition. You will study: Dissertation, Professional Practice and Final Major Project

Duration

Three years

How will I be assessed?

Practical, theoretical and design, you will be expected to undertake a number of design briefs which will be presented as critiques.

Employment into a variety of areas within the fashion industry, including Designer, Pattern Cutter, Fashion Illustrator, Merchandiser, Fashion Promotion, Tailor, Costume Designer
