3. Terms of Reference

- 1.1 The Student Council will in respect of its role:
 - Monitor and evaluate learner feedback about Academy issues
 - Ensure the voice of the learner is listened to and contributes to the Academy's quality improvement strategy
 - Provide feedback on the student experience in terms of learning and teaching
 - Comment on the Academy's self assessment report
 - Report and provide feedback to Academy's management team

4. General

- 4.1 The Academy will be established, organise and facilitate through the role of the PPD Team leader
- 4.2 The council to receive reports from case representatives
- 4.3 Minutes will be distributed as follows:
 - To all Academy representatives
 - To PPD Team Leaders
 - To all students via the website and voice of the Learner notice boards
 - To Academy Management meetings
 - To Student Parliament Representatives
- 4.4 The Academy Student Council will meet at least 6 times per year.
- 4.5 It will meet 1 week prior to the Student Parliament and its minutes will be presented to the Student Parliament.
