### ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE AND LEARN ENGLISH +

- This course runs from September until June, and there are many dates through the year that you can join or leave.
- You will learn general English, reading and writing skills, study skills and learn about British culture.
- 19 hours of class tuition plus 2 hours of directed self study per week.
- You can take an IELTS examination as part of this programme (examination fees apply).
- You can also join in with Learn English + options, adding to your learning with exciting activities (see below).

### ENGLISH SUMMER SCHOOL - 27TH JUNE 2011 TO 22ND JULY 2011

- Whether you want to learn English for business or pleasure this is an enjoyable way to improve your English over the summer break.
- There are 15 hours of classroom work each week, from Monday to Friday. Classes generally take place in the morning, leaving the afternoons free for trips and activities in the local area.
- There is one optional trip per week to historic and exciting places such as York, Chatsworth and Sheffield.

### ENGLISH PREPARATION FOR STUDY – 15TH AUGUST TO 9TH SEPTEMBER

This course is timed for students preparing to study in English at the start of the Academic Year in September

- You'll learn some new listening and reading techniques and how to take memorable and easy to follow notes.
- Getting the most out of academic books and journals.
- Practicing speaking skills and gaining confidence in the classroom.
- Techniques of academic writing, including planning an assignment essay writing, and describing diagrams and data.
- British education culture, what your tutor expects from you, and how to get the most out of working in study groups and in tutorials with other students.
- Entry requirements are IELTS examination at Band 6 (including band 6 in writing) or TOEFL or Pearson Test of English equivalent.

### LEARN ENGLISH + (PLUS)

As well as learning English in the classroom and in real life situations, you want to have a great experience! We now offer the following Learn English + options.

- Learn English + Horse Riding & Equine Care – the horse riding part of the programme takes place on Wednesday afternoons for 3 hours at Northern Racing College. Your own hat and boots are required.
- Learn English + Floristry – we can offer 2 to 6 week courses in Floristry to run alongside English.
- Learn English + Conservation – our University Campus is in beautiful woodland with historic buildings and monuments. Alongside your lessons you can work with our dedicated team that manage this historic English estate. There is rare and diverse plant life, fruit and farm animals. Activities include dry stone walling, hedge laying, woodland thinning, footpath construction and pond restoration.
- Learn English + Golf – you can combine your English study with professional golf tuition at one of Doncaster's golf courses, and also play on our 9 hole golf course at our High Melton campus.
- Learn English + Tennis – tennis is available at Doncaster Tennis Club, with tuition provided by a professional qualified tennis coach. Your own tennis racket is required.
- Learn English + Health & Fitness – students learn English alongside healthy eating, weight management and health & fitness management.
