



INCAS

An important aspect of the work of the International team is the mobilities that we organise to give our students the chance to experience living and working abroad. In our current mobility project, funded by Erasmus+, over a hundred students will have the opportunity to complete 2-week work placements in organisations across Europe and (new for us) 2 students will have the opportunity to complete 3-month placements.

We know first-hand how going on these mobilities can change the lives of participants and enhance employment prospects so therefore we are delighted to be part of a strategic partnership project which is developing resources to support student mobilities. Through the INCAS project we are working with eight European partners from Ireland, Germany, Italy, Poland, Portugal and Romania to develop existing tools and resources to 21st century technical levels for learners, teacher/trainers and work-based mentors. As well as e-learning material to support international work placements there will be a database of organisations who take part in Erasmus+ mobilities and a phone app to support recording, monitoring and assessment.

We are more than half-way through the project, the kick-off meeting was in Doncaster and two further Transnational meetings having taken place in Poland and Portugal, the fourth meeting should have been in Italy in April but of course could not take place. Instead here we are in our own homes furthering the project on a digital platform.
